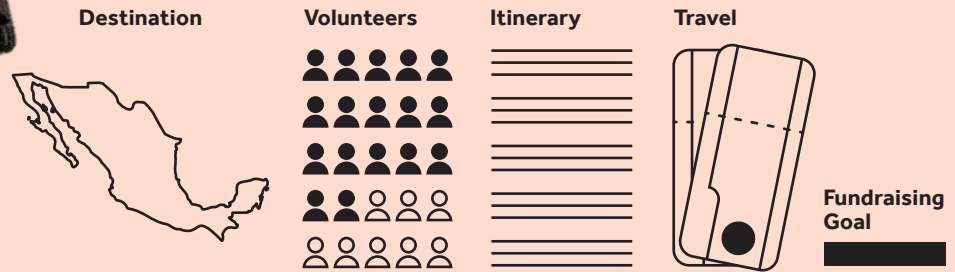

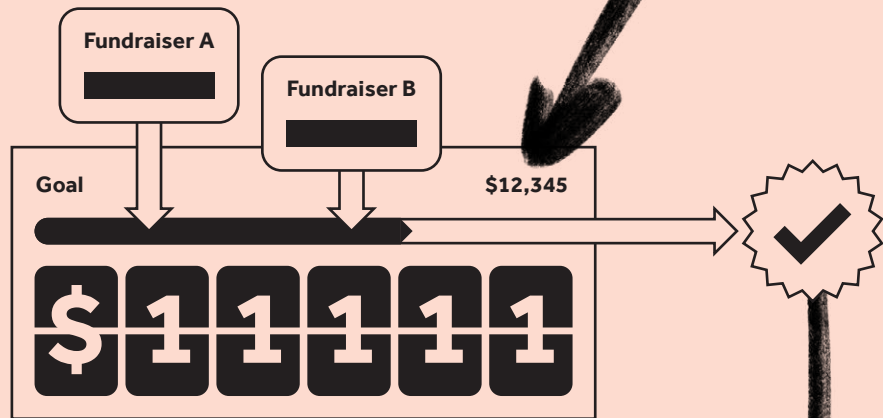

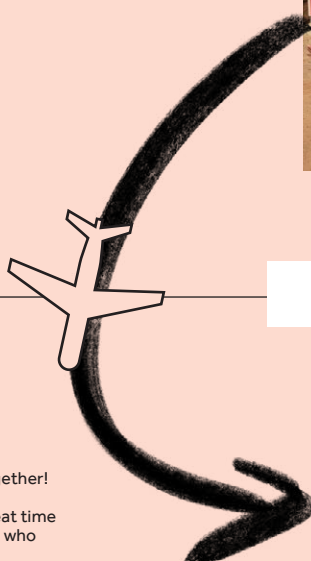
All ready for your flights? Any last minute concerns?
